Responsibilities

- Perform medical imaging examinations in compliance with CIG protocols and within an appropriate timeframe
- Show flexibility in the workplace by working at several sites in line with rostering needs
- Communicate with patients and staff effectively in all areas of medical imaging procedures
- Conduct examinations in a caring and professional manner
- Work effectively in a team environment
- Assist in the education of student radiographers.
- Understand nursing procedures for the patients examined, and the procedures for medical emergencies, infection control and interventional techniques
- Monitor equipment to ensure it is functioning properly and report any faults
- Understand the principles of radiation safety and the implications regarding safe use of the equipment
- Understand and apply CIG OHS standards
- Undertake continuing education to ensure maintenance of skills and the ability to adopt newly developed techniques in medical imaging
- Attend Site and Practice meetings as needed
- Other duties as needed

Selection Criteria

- Qualifications as stated above and successful completion of a PDY year
- Demonstrated enthusiasm for the profession and a willingness to learn
- Demonstrated ability to produce high quality imaging on a variety of equipment in a variety of settings
- Current participation in a CPD program
- Excellent communication skills with both patients and team members
- Ability to provide a high quality service with a strong customer focus
- Flexibility to move between sites as per the CIG roster
