IMPORTANT INFORMATION We collect personal information about you (including personal details, patient reports, x-rays and other medical images) for the purpose of providing you with health and imaging services. This information is stored on an electronic database and may be accessed by employees, agents, officers and personnel of ACT X-Ray Services Pty Limited (ABN 93 245 601 531) and its related entities. We may also disclose your personal information to your treating team, which may include, the practitioner who referred you to us, or other practitioners, including medical specialists, practitioners (including allied health professionals) from which you seek a second opinion, or, if you have switched General Practitioners (GP), to your new GP (your treating team). We may also hold personal information about you on our database that relates to previous medical procedures. To ensure you receive the best possible care, we may disclose this information to your treating team upon their request. If your personal information is not stored in our database, your practitioner (or other specialists and practitioners who need to review your information in order to provide medical advice) may not have access to this information. Your personal information may also be accessed by parties who are responsible for maintaining and operating the electronic database, but only to the extent necessary to ensure the proper functioning of the database. We disclose your personal information to recipients located outside of Australia. 16 years or older

63551 MRI Head

Referral by a medical practitioner (excluding a specialist or consultant physician) for a scan of head for a patient 16 years or older for any of the following:

- » unexplained seizure(s)
- » chronic unexplained headache with suspected intracranial pathology

63554 MRI Cervical Spine

Referral by a medical practitioner (excluding a specialist or consultant physician) for a scan of spine for a patient 16 years or older for suspected:

- » cervical radiculopathy

63557 MRI Cervical Spine

Referral by a medical practitioner (excluding a specialist or consultant physician) for a scan of spine for a patient 16 years or older for suspected:

- » cervical spine trauma

63560 MRI Knee

Referral by a medical practitioner (excluding a specialist or consultant physician) for a scan of knee following acute knee trauma for a patient 16-49 years with:

- » inability to extend the knee suggesting the possibility of acute meniscal tear; or
- » clinical findings suggesting acute anterior cruciate ligament tear

Under the age of 16 years

63507 MRI Head

Referral by a medical practitioner (excluding a specialist or consultant physician) for a scan of head for a patient under 16 years for any of the following:

- » unexplained seizure(s); or
- » unexplained headache where significant pathology is suspected; or
- » paranasal sinus pathology which has not responded to conservative therapy

63510 MRI Spine

Referral by a medical practitioner (excluding a specialist or consultant physician) for a scan of spine for a patient under 16 years following radiographic examination for:

- » significant trauma; or
- » unexplained neck or back pain with associated neurological signs; or
- » unexplained back pain where significant pathology is suspected

63513 MRI Knee

Referral by a medical practitioner (excluding a specialist or consultant physician) for a scan of knee for a patient under 16 years for internal joint derangement

63516 MRI Hip

Referral by a medical practitioner (excluding a specialist or consultant physician) for a scan of hip for a patient under 16 years following radiographic examination for:

- » suspected septic arthritis; or
- » suspected slipped capital femoral epiphysis; or
- » suspected Perthes disease

63519 MRI Elbow

Referral by a medical practitioner (excluding a specialist or consultant physician) for a scan of elbow for a patient under 16 years following radiographic examination where a significant fracture or avulsion injury is suspected that will change management

63522 MRI Wrist

Referral by a medical practitioner (excluding a specialist or consultant physician) for a scan of wrist for a patient under 16 years following radiographic examination where scaphoid fracture is suspected.
